New Delhi, 6 February 2023: The 11th edition of now the world's largest International Plastics Exhibition PLASTINDIA 2023 has been a grand success. The 5-day conference (Feb 1st to 5th) witnessed a high footfall of 3.60 lakh visitors. One of the most comprehensive exhibitions for the plastics industry, around 1800 exhibitors showcased their latest world-standard processing machinery, raw materials, Recycling technology, and latest automation technologies in PLASTINDIA 2023.
